College Fund Raffle Rules and Regulations

Children's Museum of the Lowcountry is a nonprofit organization participating in a raffle with all proceeds going toward the pursuit of our mission: "Engage young children's potential by inviting families of all backgrounds to explore environments and experiences that spark imagination and stimulate curiosity through the power of PLAY." The Children's Museum of the Lowcountry is grateful to all raffle participants for their generous support!

Raffle Rules:

- Employees and Board members (and their immediate family members or family in the same household) of Children's Museum of the Lowcountry are not eligible to purchase raffle tickets, be named as a beneficiary of the prize.
- A maximum of 2,000 tickets will be sold at the raffle ticket price of \$40. The chances of winning are based on the number of tickets sold.
- TICKET PRICE IS NOT TAX DEDUCTIBLE.
- No Children's Museum of the Lowcountry purchase (donation, gift shop, membership, etc.) is necessary to win.
- Tickets will be sold online and through our front desk at Children's Museum of the Lowcountry, 25 Ann Street, Charleston, SC 29403.
- The raffle is open to all United States citizens or legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age and older.
- Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- The winner is responsible for disclosing/reporting winnings to the IRS and any tax liability that may be due.
- Online and onsite ticket sales will cease at 1:59PM on December 31, 2018.
- The winner will be drawn on December 31, 2018 at 3:00PM. Winner does not need to be present to win. The winner will be notified by either phone or email address provided with entry information. Winner has 72 hours from drawing to respond to the Museum. If no contact is made, winner forfeits winnings and another winner will be drawn.

- Upon closing of raffle, Children’s Museum of the Lowcountry will place any participant who has purchased a ticket into a 50/50 drawing where one winner will be selected as the winner of 50 percent of the total raffle sales as of 2:00PM on December 31, 2018.
- If the winner accepts the prize of the 50/50 drawing, the prize will be submitted only to the Future Scholar 529 College Savings Plan on behalf of the winner. The funds will be issued by check directly to the 529 Plan Provider from Children’s Museum of the Lowcountry in the name of the winner. The winner will provide the Provider with the information for the beneficiary of the 529 plan (one specific child).
- If the winner of the prize does not already have a Future Scholar 529 plan account, an account will need to be established for the winner prior to the distribution of the prize.
- Children’s Museum of the Lowcountry assumes no responsibilities for taxes. The prize will not be given in cash. The prize will be issued by check only to the 529 Plan Provider. The Provider name must be given to Children’s Museum of the Lowcountry within 30 days of the winner being announced.
- Children’s Museum of the Lowcountry is not responsible for any funds once they are received by 529 Plan Provider. The winner shall not hold Children’s Museum of the Lowcountry responsible for any investments made by the 529 Plan Provider.
