## 2020 Schoolseum Terms and Conditions

My child has my permission to attend and participate in CML's Schoolseum. I know of no medical reason why my child should not attend or participate.

### 1. **COVID-19**

In granting permission for my child to attend CML Museum School, I understand the risks inherent with such attendance, including, but not limited to, the risk of infection from COVID-19 ("Coronavirus"). I accept responsibility for notifying and will notify CML staff if my child or someone with whom my child has recently had close contact: (1) exhibits symptoms of the Coronavirus, including but not limited to fever, chills, cough, trouble breathing, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and/or new loss of taste or smell; (2) tests positive for the Coronavirus, has been diagnosed by a medical professional as having the Coronavirus, or is awaiting test results for the Coronavirus; or (3) is exposed to a confirmed outbreak of the Coronavirus or a person who has tested positive for the Coronavirus; or (4) has traveled internationally or to a highly impacted area within the United States within the last 14 days I understand that my child will be sent home immediately if he/she meets any of these criteria and no refunds or credits will be given. Students meeting the above criteria may return to school with written doctor's permission.

### 2. **Liability Waiver**

In consideration of your accepting my entry, I hereby, for myself, my child, my heir, executors and administrators, waiver and release any and all rights and claims for damages I or my child may have against the Children's Museum of the Lowcountry and its representatives, successors and assigns for any and all injuries suffered by myself or my child at any activity sponsored by these groups. I understand that I am encouraged to maintain proper insurance coverage for my child during the duration of his/her participation and specified activities with CML. I do hereby certify all the information to be correct and true.

### 3. **Acceptable Behavior Policy**

In order to ensure a safe, productive, and fun environment for all, children are expected to behave in an acceptable manner and use appropriate language at all times. All children are expected to comply with health and safety policies related to COVID-19. It is important to remember that there are no refunds or credits given if a child is asked to leave school due to unacceptable behavior.
